Living Water Mission was founded in 2009 and on an annual basis a small team travels to Eldoret, Kenya to install water wells. The focus of these trips are really about helping the Kenyans learn how to help themselves. Living Water Mission has moved on to other projects including the building of a Zero Graze Unit and the purchase of 4 cows. This unit provides the cows with a contained area with better nutrition, leading to more cow milk to sell. Milk is a large commodity in Kenya. This group has also moved on to supporting daily food for 50 children. The feeding program will be sustainable at the end of the year.
