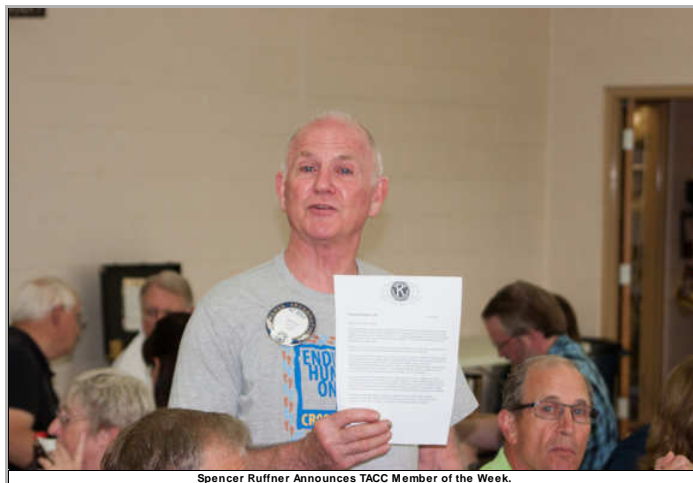

• Fine Session

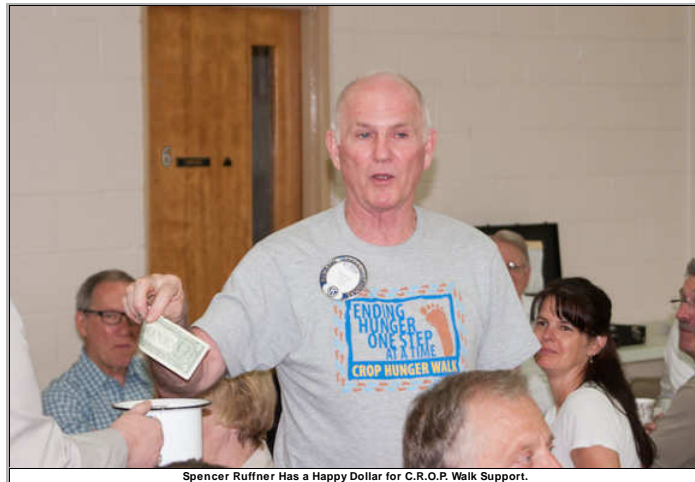
