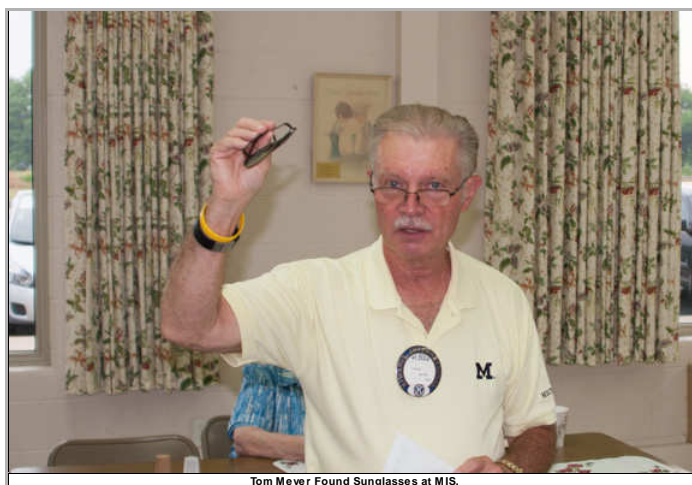
• Announcements

• Program

Spencer Ruffner introduced our speaker this morning: Donna Yearsin from Celebrate Recovery.

Celebrate Recovery is a Christ-centered 12 Step program for anyone who struggles with any hurt, hang-up or habit. When we hear the word "recovery", we often think of drugs and alcohol. At Celebrate Recovery we give people a safe place to work on things other than just chemical addictions. People need recovery for anger, depression, over-eating, codependency, anxiety, and issues that come from being abused. CR offers hope for all of these and more.

John and Cheryl Baker founded CR over 23 years ago. Their vision for Celebrate Recovery is "for the church to provide a safe place where families could find healing and restoration. Where moms, dads, and their children of all ages could find freedom from the hurts, hang-ups and habits." Healing for the family is one of the main differences between secular recovery and Celebrate Recovery. CR has developed two programs that serve the younger members of the family; the Landing for teens and Celebration Place for children 5 to 12 years of age.

When parents struggle, children are affected. Children need a place of their own to talk about their feelings. As adults learn a new way to live as they deal with their problems, children learn life skills to help them deal with their current family situation and skills to prepare them for a more productive life. Lives are changed and families are restored by working the steps of recovery one day at a time.
