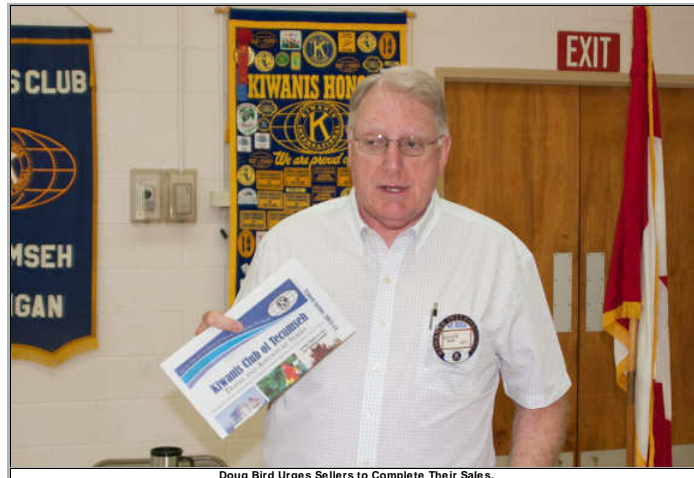

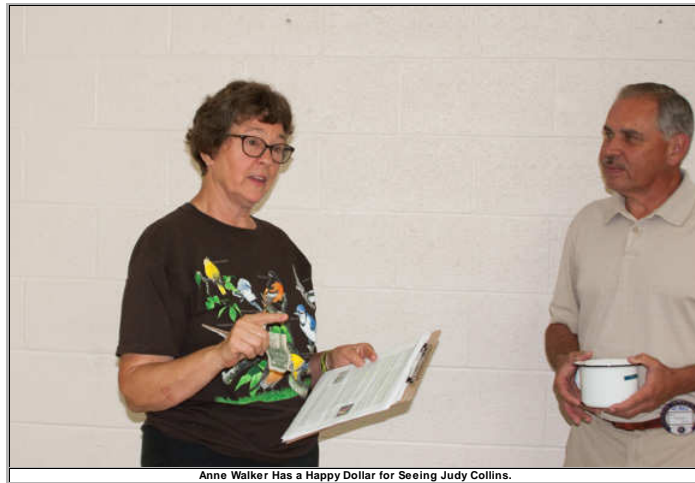

Bryan and Heather Masten presented this morning's program on the Ronald McDonald House at C. S. Mott's Children's Hospital in Ann Arbor. A short video gave an overview of the facilities and how they work. Our club will be preparing and serving dinner at Ronald McDonald House for the families there on Sunday, July 13th, 6:00-8:00 PM. If you are interested in participating or contributing food, contact Bryan or Heather.

There are 10 rooms for families within the hospital itself for short-term stays and a separate building for housing families who will be there for a longer period. This program helped 1500 families last year to be close to their loved ones while they were being treated. The facility estimates that it costs about \$75 a night for a family's stay. They ask family's to contribute \$10 a night, but no one is turned away. [CLICK HERE](#) for more information on the program.
