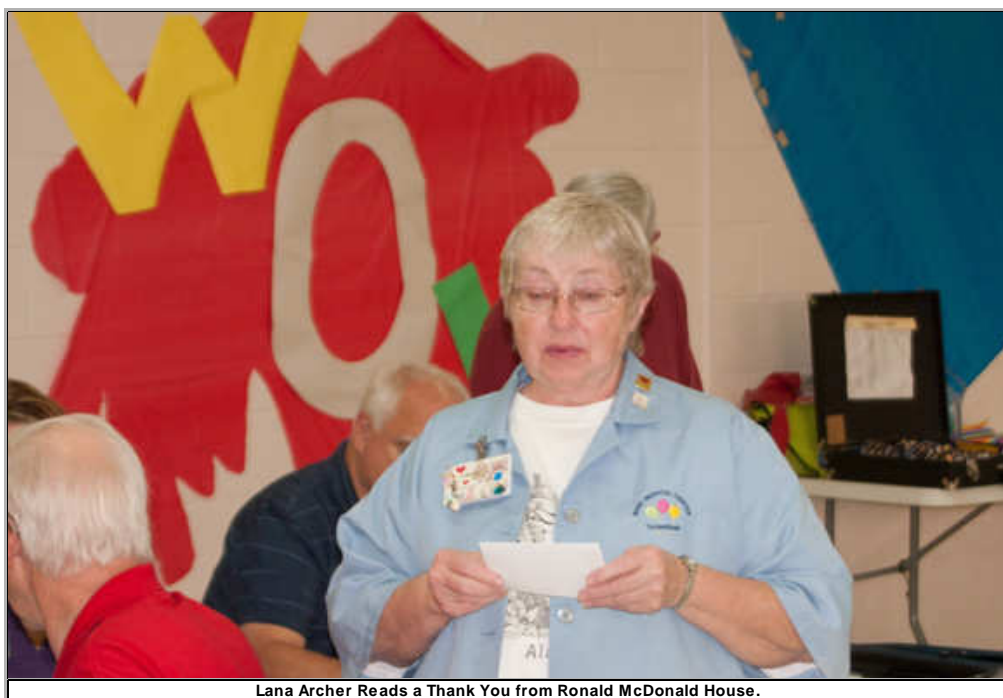

- Susan Gilmore also had thank-you cards from our speaker last week and two other recipients of Kiwanis support.



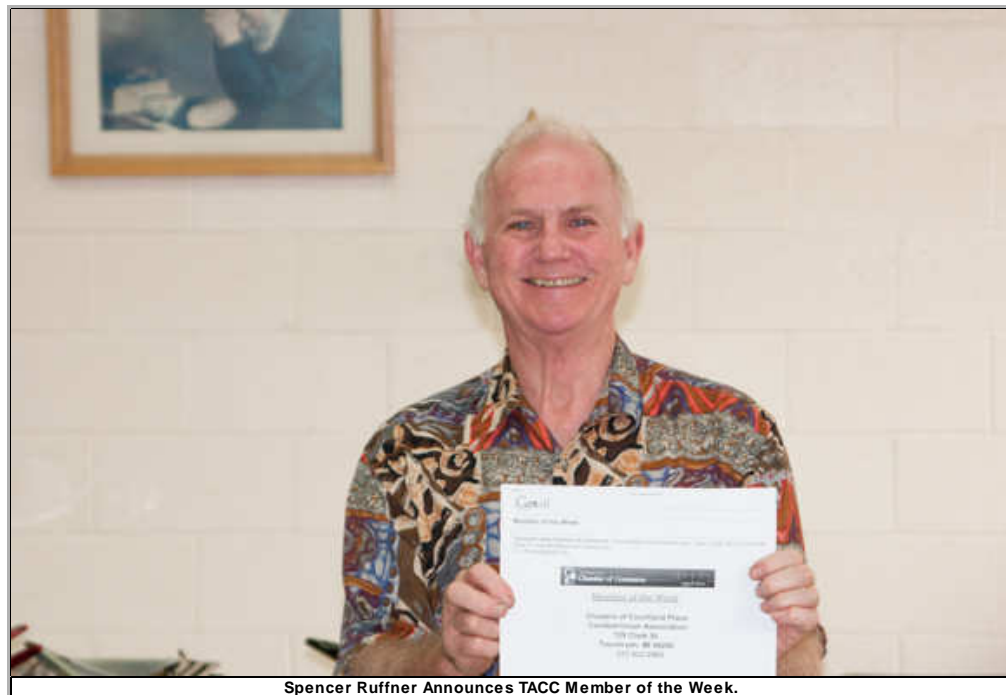
