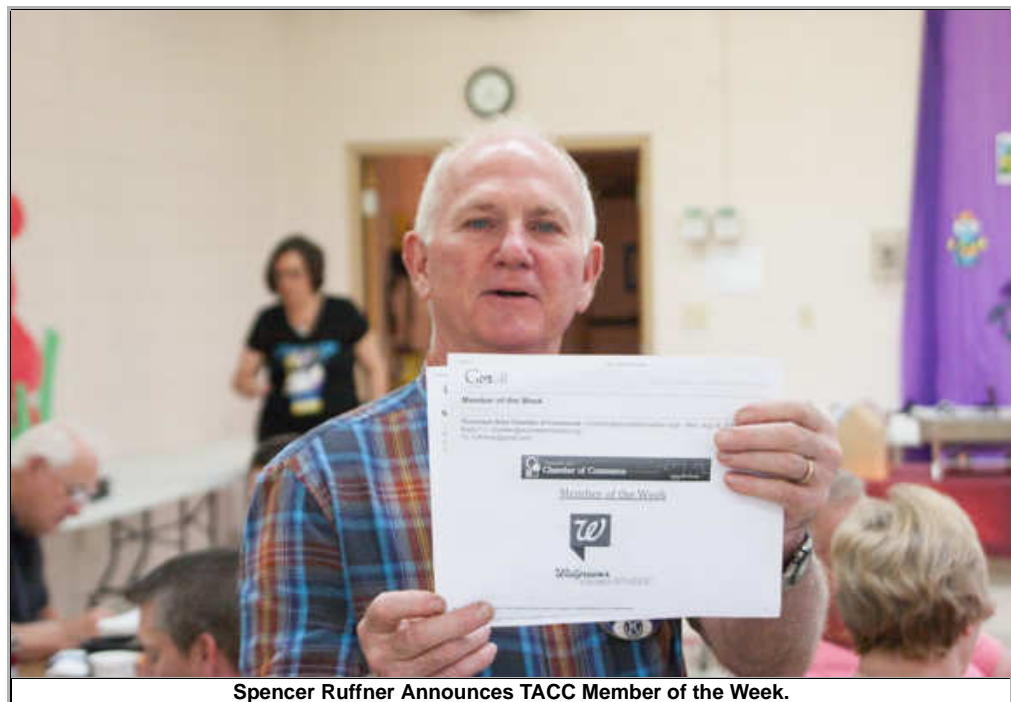

• Program

Our program for today was a report from Wendy Brys and Jody Howard on the Michigan District Convention. It was held this year in Kalamazoo, and 322 Kiwanians attended. Key Club, Circle K Club and Aktion Club governors were all guest speakers.

The Michigan District consists of 166 Kiwanis clubs with 5125 members. In addition, there are 96 Key Clubs with 5475 members and 32 Aktion Clubs with 890 members.

Sue Petrisin, the Kiwanis International President Elect, also attended. She is from Michigan, having been the governor of the Michigan Key Club, the Michigan Circle K Club and the Michigan District. She now works at the Michigan State Alumni Association and will become the first ever woman president of Kiwanis International.

The Michigan District Convention installed Rebecca Hildridge as the new governor for 2014-2015. At 27 years old, she becomes the youngest person to have held that office. She promises a coming "techy new year" with lots of changes to appeal to the younger generation. The focus for 2014-2015 will be on retaining existing members and recruiting new ones.
