Tecumseh Swim Team Swimmers Clinton Olberg and Ashley Dempsey along with coaches Sarah Eubanks and Deb Followell.

Sarah stated that they have a club program with 80 swimmers age 6 to 18 within that program there is a group of 20 students in the USA program with swimmers 4 of the 12 and under going to the Michigan State meet with 1 girl going to sectional meet.

They have 10 girls on the team but had 5 go to state meet. They ended up in 10 place at the state meet with 3 all state swims. They have 22 boys and girls on the middle School coed team.

Deb Followell stated this is the 5th year as coach of the boys team. They have 29 boys on the swim team with 4 divers 1 is qualified for regionals with 4 swimmers qualified for state meet at this time. All three of their relay teams qualified for the state meet. Aside from the boys team they have the community pool group called friends of the pool. Friends of the pool worked with MJR to promoting the movie "Touch the Wall"

Swimmers recently enjoyed the movie "Touch the Wall".

Swimmers Clinton and Ashley spoke on why they like the Kiwanis Swim meet.

The Kiwanis Swim meet is a non score meet. It takes the pressure off the competitors and is just fun for the kids. Swimmers get to loosen up when competing and Freshmen can get medals. The meet gives swimmers self confidence and separates the older swimmers from the younger ones.

Pool temperatures are maintained between 79 and 82 degrees by state regulation.

Girls compete in the Fall and Boys compete in the Winter. Mid Winter season boys bleach their hair.
