Sharon thanked Tecumseh Kiwanis for the privilege of attending the convention. Wendy attended the Service Leadership program. All Kiwanis families attended the convention at same time which does not usually happen. Wendy attended Circle K and Key Club presentation and Sharon attended Aktion Club presentation.

New recruitment Formula Initiative – Love It, Share It, Live It

Kiwanis has been partners with Unicef since 1994. This year IHOP is a new partner along with AHI Travel.

This year's convention continued to celebrate our 100th year with people dressed in costume of the decades. Next year's convention will be in Canada where they will be celebrating 100 years.

Sharon attended the Birthday celebration. Kiwanis was born in Detroit in 1915. The first International club was formed in Canada in 1916. In 100 years Kiwanis has expanded with Key Clubs, Circle K , in 1987 women were admitted to membership, Builders club, K Kids, IDD campaign, 2000 Aktion clubs and the MNT campaign which is nearing its end.

Tim Harris was Key note speaker at the opening session. He was born with Down's Syndrome and had graduated with certificates. He has a restaurant called Tim's Place where he serves breakfast, lunch and hugs.

Wendy partied with incoming International President, Sue Petrisin (the first female president of any international service club) and Sharon spent time with husband Kim at a campground.

At the business meeting 9 amendments were voted. Greater flexibility of meeting and club satellites – approved.. District Convention deadline moved to September 25 – approved. Corporate membership adopted permanently – approved. Business of Kiwanis International can be done web based – failed. International dues raised to \$52 – approved. International can adjust dues annually by no more than 5% - failed and International oversight of foundations charitable funds – failed.

Project Ideas to Share:

Table for Two, a school meal partnership with Snap Pea Company was presented by Sharon. We will received 36,000 meals to give out.

K Corps – Club to club exchange program where children can be hosted for 2 weeks.

Increased involvement in Builders Club, Key Club, Aktion Club at Hope Recreation Cetner and Circle K at Adrian College.

Each of us can do something.

We helped sponsor a member, Bryan and sponsor, Dillon from our Aktion Club at Hope Recreation so they could attend the convention. Dillon will speak to us at a future meeting about the experience.
