o **Kiwani Own:** Carlton Cook

90 year old Carlton was born in Sturgis Michigan. He lived in White Pidgeon, a town of 1200 people which now has a population of 1201 he thinks. He graduated from White Pidgeon High School on D Day. He applied to the Army Air Corp and was told they would call him. He then attended Michigan State and was eventually called into service. In 1945 to went to Biloxi Mississippi where he remained until he was discharged as a cadet along with veterans.

He returned to MSU in a student in pre-med. In the Fall of 1947 he recognized a kid from White Pidgeon getting off a bus on the MSU campus. He asked Lynne what she was doing there? She was a new student studying Home Ec. He offered to assist her to Williams Hall. They were married in his 2-3 year of med school.

He had worked for years on a farm but in 1951 was looking for work associated with his chosen career. A Tecumseh practice was looking for an Extern. Lynne was pregnant when they came here. They were living in a trailer in a back yard with a phone line running from the main house to them. He was financially in the hole and went to work in Howell. He was found by Dick Dustin at a Michigan Medical Society meeting and got a call from Tecumseh doctors offering him money to move back to Tecumseh to practice.

He and Lynne had 5 kids.
