## Announcements

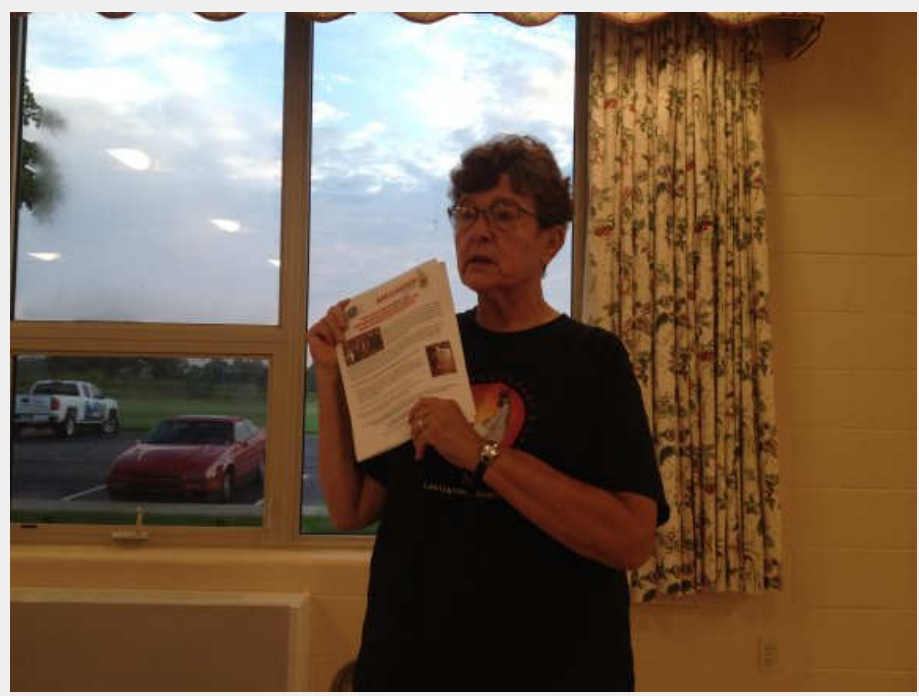

*Brian Callaghan – will be sending new route lists to route chairs.*



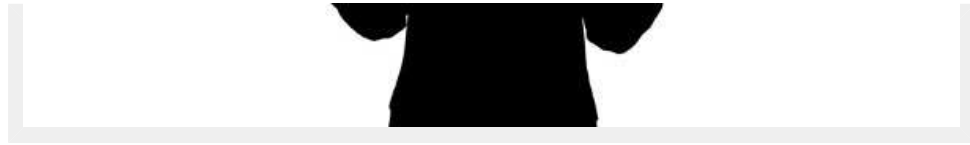
