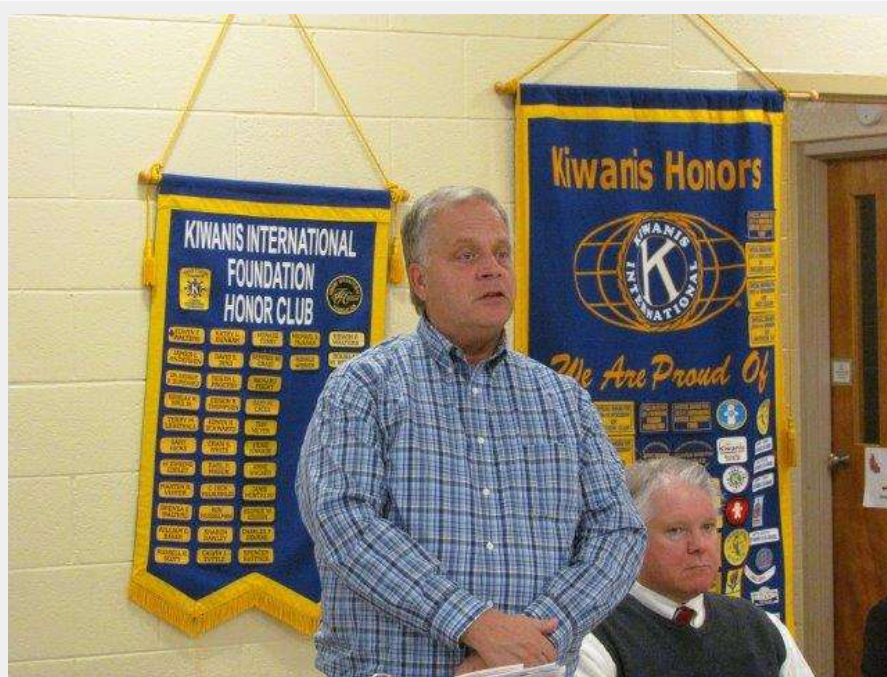
Megan Freitas, member of SADD, NHS, Varsity Club, and played volleyball, basketball, and soccer. She will attend Central studying bio med and pre med.

Mark Tommelein was our fine master with questions on Michigan Lakes and Fishing.

There are 2 free fishing weekends, one in February and one in January.

A fishing license costs \$26 a year.

License funds are the only source of funds for habitat and fish stocking. The DNR receives no tax dollars.

Daily limit of bluegill, perch etc. is 25 in any combination. State record bluegill is 2.7 pounds and for a small mouth is 9.98 pounds. It was caught in the Indian River.

Daily limit for bass, pike and walleye is 5 in any combo.

There are 11,037 inland or 5 acre lakes in Michigan.

The record species fish, was a Sturgeon and was caught in 1974.



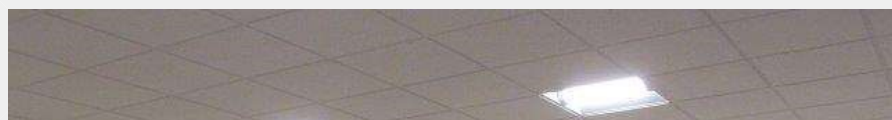

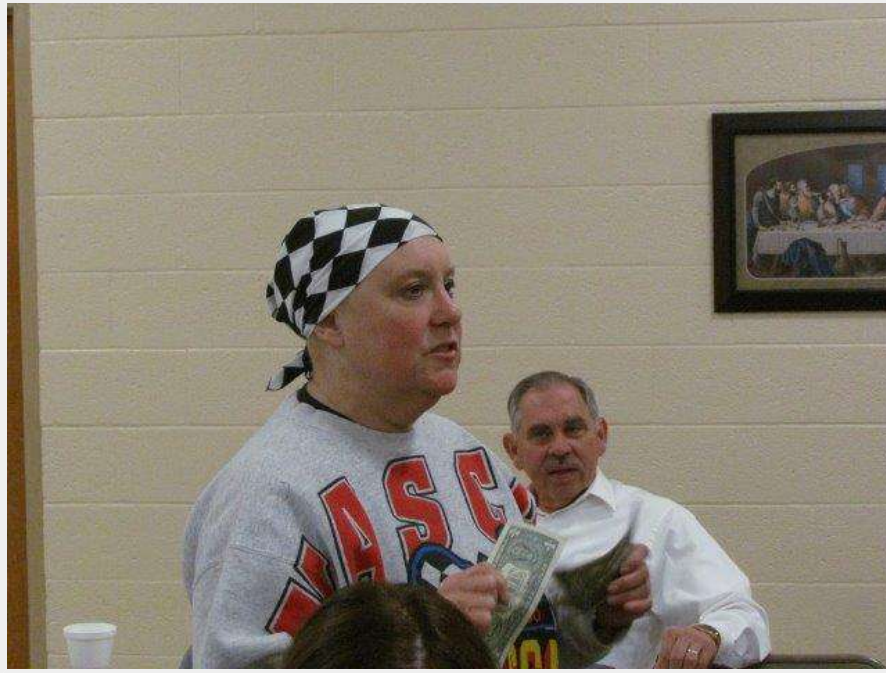




Dan Meikle - Ruth Crosby's first birthday in heaven would have been her 99th birthday on earth.

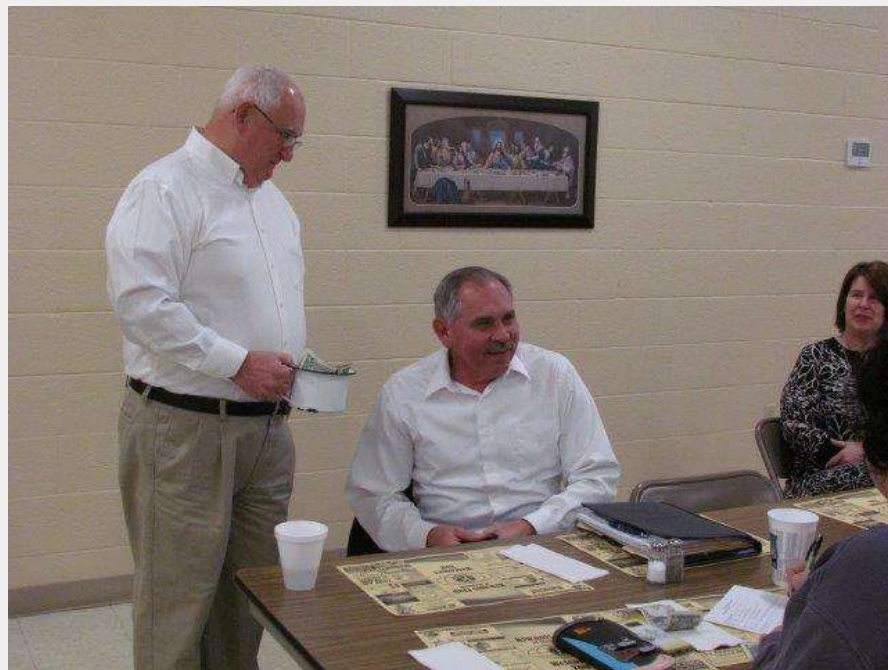
