*We all sang to Wendy and Bob Brys, for their 34 years on the 20th.*

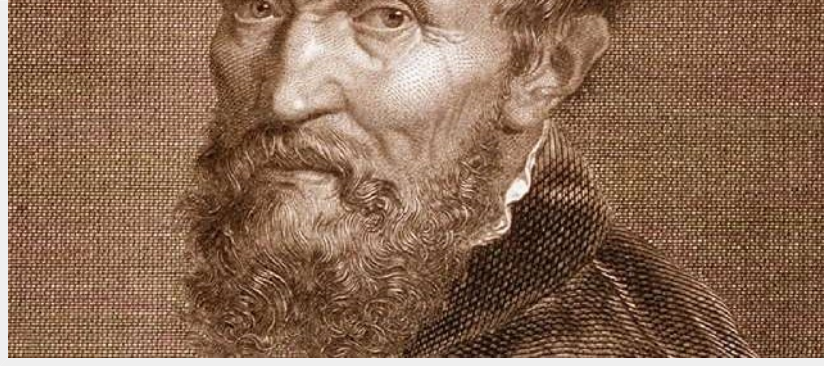

## **Fine Session**





*Spencer quizzed us on some art history focusing on "Michelangelo Di Lodovico Buonarroti Simoni"*

*Meaning of the multiple names*

*First name Michelangelo.*

*Di is from Lodovico even though he was from Caprese (This is a family name instead of location)*

*Another Family name (Thought to be from his mother's side): Buonarroti*

*Family name (from his father): Simoni*

*1) Birth year of Michelangelo? 1360, (1475), 1592*

*2) Born in? Florence, Rome, (Caprese)*

*3) Because of Michelangelo's mother's health they moved to Florence, Michelangelo as an infant was raised by another family of what trade? (Stonecutter) where he later joked, "With my wet-nurse's milk, I sucked in the hammer and chisels I use for my statues."*

*4) Michelangelo had no interest in the family business Banking - his father was also a Judicial Administrator.*

*At the age of 13 his father apprenticed him to a Florentine painter's workshop. There Michelangelo was exposed to the technique of Fresco.*

*What is Fresco?, Painting with oil on canvas, sculpture with a hammer and chisel, (painting with water colors on moist plaster) Michelangelo only spent a year in this workshop.*

*5) Michelangelo moved into a palace of a Florentine Ruler "Lorenzo the Magnificent" of the family NAME? (Medici) to study classical sculpture in the family's Sculpture gardens.*

*6) The house of Medici had a flag with 5 round red balls in the shape of a shield and a 6th blue ball with three crosses.*

*7) Michelangelo's gain special permission from? (The Catholic Church) to study Cadavers to gain insight to anatomy. Though exposure to the corpses had adverse effect on his health.*

*8) Michelangelo is widely regarded as the most famous artist of the Italian Renaissance. Among his works are? 9) ("David" and "Pieta" statues and the "Sistine Chapel frescoes")*

*10) What is the sculpture Pieta of? (Virgin Mary mourning over the body of the dead Christ with Christ held on her lap).*

*11) The physical rigor of painting the Sistine Chapel had taken its toll on Michelangelo, and he soon turned his focus toward architecture.*

*Michelangelo continued to work on the tomb of Julius II for the next several decades. He also designed the Medici Chapel and the Laurentian Library-located opposite the Basilica San Lorenzo in Florence-to house the Medici book collection. These buildings are considered a turning point in architectural history.*



*But Michelangelo's crowning glory in this field came when he was made chief architect of?( St. Peter's Basilica in 1546).  
12) Although he always considered himself a Florentine, Michelangelo lived most of his life in Rome, where he died in 1564, at age 88.  
Although many were stumped by questions, Chuck Gehrke, Tom Meyer or Gale Hazelbaker were able to answer many of the questions.*
