*Doug Bird - Travel and Adventure Brochures are available for businesses etc. Thank you to all who made this project successful.*

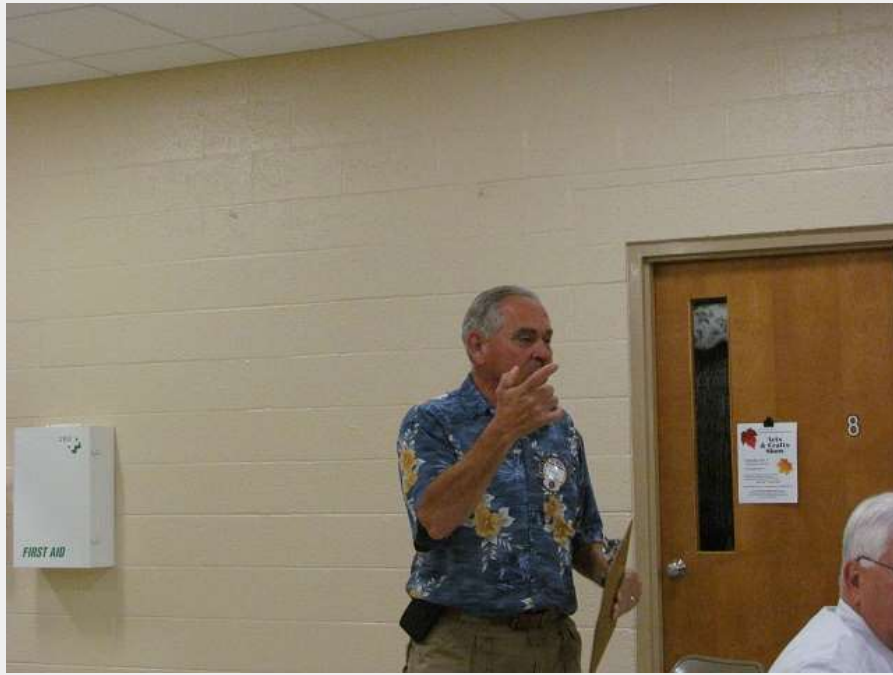


*Lana Archer - Associated Charities "Nights of Hearts" fundraiser/dinner/dance is Saturday October 21. She has tickets available for \$50.*
